# **Access Statement**

# **Accessibility**

We aim to help all people to access our facilities and to have a good experience – if you have any questions or need particular assistance please don't hesitate to ask.

#### **General Access**

The ground floor accommodation in on two slightly different levels but all is accessible by gentle slopes, either internally or externally direct from the street outside. The two upstairs rooms are only accessible via a narrow staircase.

#### **Toilets**

An accessible toilet is provided, which also has baby-changing facilities.

## **Parking**

There is no public parking on site, but the town has both restricted street parking and pay car parking nearby. For blue badge holders, there are two public spaces immediately outside the church.

## **Public Transport**

The coastal Bus route 700 stops within easy walking distance and local bus route 27 runs between Havant and the old hospital site via North Emsworth and Denvilles. Emsworth train station is approximately 0.3 miles to the north.

# Dogs

Guide, therapy and Assistant Dogs are welcome, and a drinking bowl of water is provided.

## Hearing

A hearing loop system is available during services and in International Hall when required.
